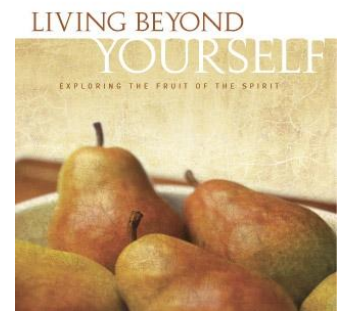
- A. Just what is the church anyway?

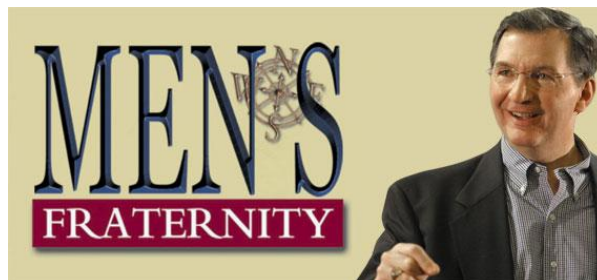
